I originally trained as a quantity surveyor, and whilst working in private practices, architects' offices and a variety of construction companies, I developed an interest in the legal aspects of the construction industry. I subsequently studied for and qualified as an Arbitrator and an Adjudicator.

I act as Adjudicator on a broad diversity of construction disputes concerning liability and quantum. I have received over 100 such appointments to date, resolving major and minor disputes within England, Scotland and Wales.

In my position as Adjudicator, I draw upon over 40 years of extensive experience as a quantity surveyor, within both the professional and commercial aspects of the industry. I have worked within the offices of professional quantity surveyors and regional and international construction companies.

During these years, I have become familiar with most standard forms of construction contract and subcontract; and I have worked, frequently, within the constraints of bespoke agreements. I have developed a comprehensive knowledge and experience of the analysis and resolution of contractual and commercial claims and other submissions within both major and minor building and civil engineering projects.

I am on the panel of Adjudicators for the Chartered Institute of Arbitrators, the Royal Institution of Chartered Surveyors, the Royal Institute of British Architects, the Technology & Construction Solicitors Association and the Academy of Independent Construction Adjudicators Construction Industry Council.
